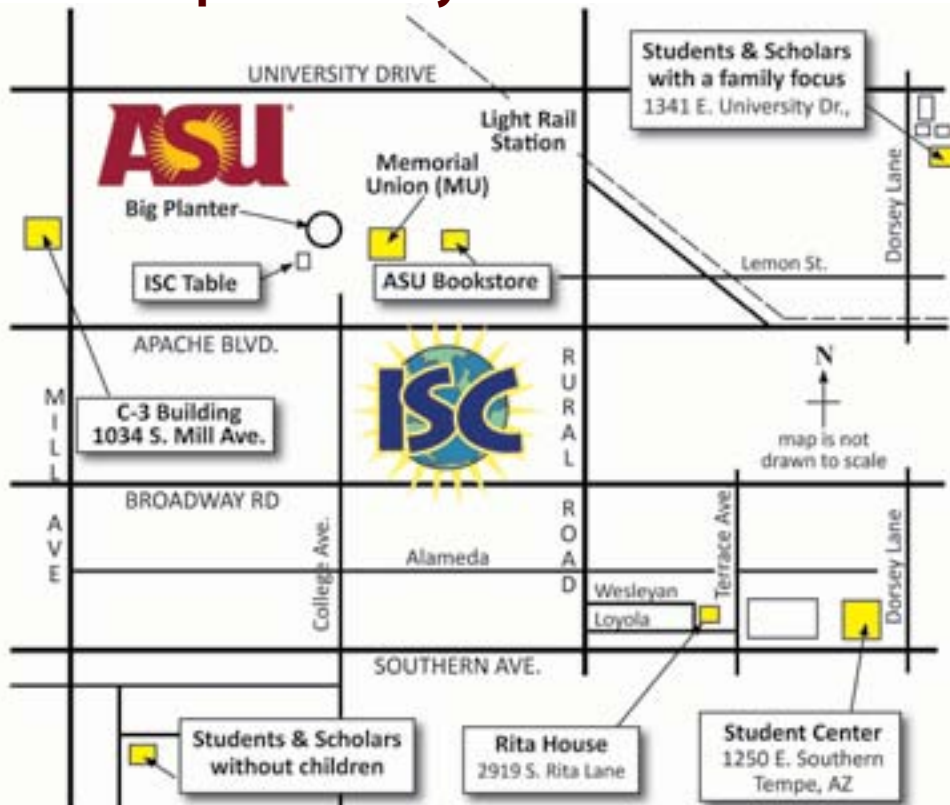
Women's Book Club
