## Free ESL Conversation Classes with interactive lessons

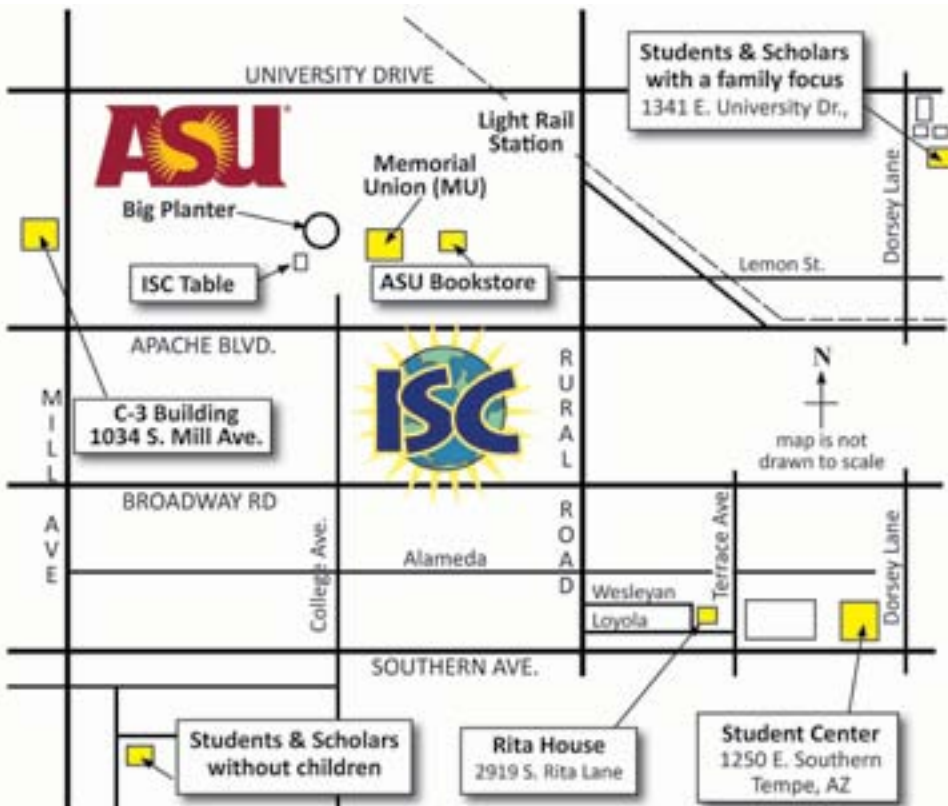
