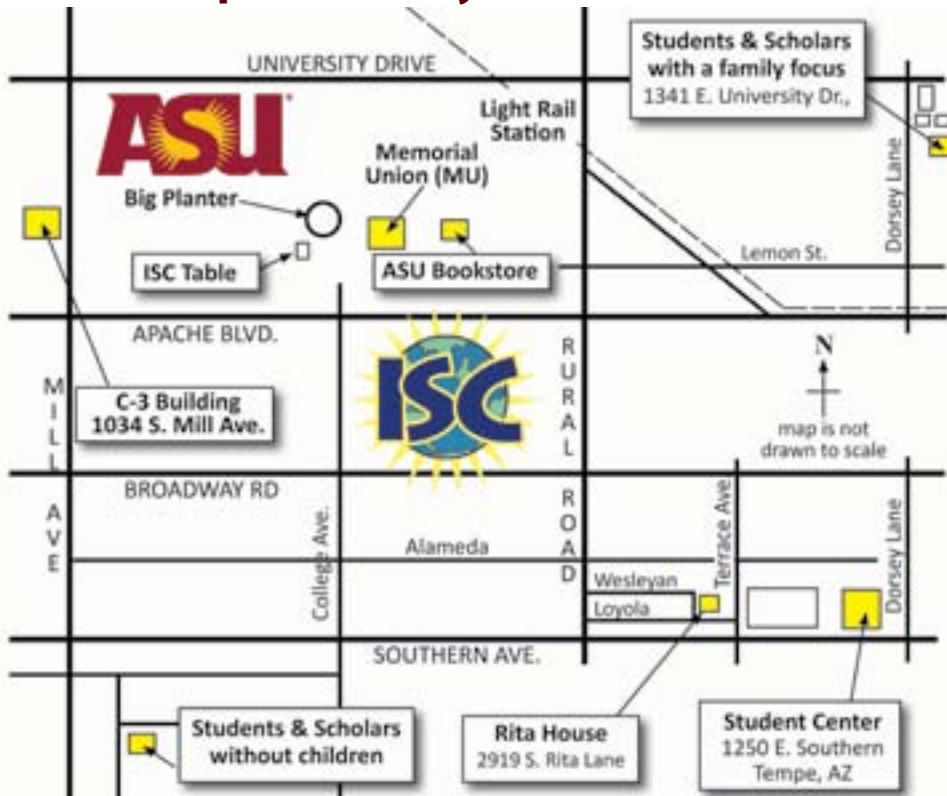


Saturday, November 10
